NOTICE OF DISPOSITION – DOCKET 2017-2

This notice reflects proposed amendments considered by the Commodity Classification Standards Board (CCSB) at the public meeting on May 23, 2017, and the action of the CCSB on each proposal.

Dispositions resulting in amendments to the National Motor Freight Classification® (NMFC®) will be published in a supplement to the NMFC, unless reconsideration is granted in accordance with the CCSB's rules. The supplement is scheduled to be issued on July 6, 2017, with an effective date of August 5, 2017, except as otherwise noted.

The CCSB may, in its discretion and for good cause shown, reconsider any docketed proposal on which disposition has been made. Requests for reconsideration must be made by mail, email or fax by a party of record to the proposal and must be received in my office no later than 5:00 pm Eastern Time, June 12, 2017.

As modified, item 43525, which names "Borax (Sodium Borate), puffed or expanded, NOI," is amended to assign class 175 to the 4 but less than 6 pcf density interval, but to avoid conflict with companion item 43520, will otherwise retain the nine-subprovision density/class progression shown. Also as modified, item 177010, which names "Solar Collectors; Solar Absorber Plates; or Solar Water Heaters," is removed from this proposal, reflective of action taken on Subject 13. (See Subject 11 for additional action on item 172670.)
