National Motor Freight Traffic Association (NMFTA) and National Classification Committee (NCC) Elects Officers

Alexandria, VA— The National Motor Freight Traffic Association and National Classification Committee elected officers at their meetings held August 5-9, 2006 in Whistler, BC Canada. It was the first NMFTA/NCC meeting held outside of the US and it reflects the Association's celebration of its 50th Anniversary and its commitment to expand involvement of carriers throughout North America.

NMFTA is a nonprofit membership association representing more than 1100 less-than-truckload carriers throughout North America.

- NMFTA's new Chairman is Bill H. Moore, President of Roseville Motor Express, Inc. which is headquartered in Crooksville, Ohio, 50 miles east of Columbus.
- The new Vice Chairman is Robert B. Block, Secretary/Treasurer of Dixie Freight, headquartered in Cypress, Texas, northwest of Houston.

The NCC is an autonomous standing committee responsible for maintaining and updating the National Motor Freight Classification. Each year 100 carrier representatives are elected to represent the over 1100 motor carriers participating in the NMFC. The NCC is regulated by the United States Surface Transportation Board.
