**NMFTA/CCSB/CRC MEETING IN ALEXANDRIA, VA - ANOTHER SUCCESS!**

Alexandria, VA - The National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc. (NMFTA) held its June Meeting in Alexandria, Virginia from Sunday, June 1st to Tuesday, June 3rd. This marks the second meeting of the NMFTA | Commodity Classification Standards Board (CCSB) | Classification Resource Committee (CRC) since the implementation of the new organizational structure and procedures.

In attendance at both the Open Meeting of the CRC and the Open Meeting of the CCSB was NMFTA General Counsel John R. Bagileo to ensure that meeting procedures were in compliance with antitrust regulations and requirements. Furthermore, written procedures in conjunction with antitrust guidelines were reviewed and approved by the CRC for the conduct of meetings.

The CCSB considered 29 classification proposals and 1 reconsideration. Shipper representatives appearing in connection with the reconsideration participated in the deliberation of that subject. Additionally, a number of committee and subcommittee meetings took place during the course of the 3 days including the Weighing and Research Committee, Interline Procedures Committee, Government Relations Committee, and Outreach Subcommittee, allowing for more in-depth discussions.
